



## Middlewich Primary School Curriculum



At Middlewich Primary School, we aim to provide pupils with a high-quality Phonics education. We follow the Little Wandle Phonics Scheme to deliver structured and effective lessons. The scheme provides a clear and systematic approach to teaching phonics, focusing on helping children build strong reading and writing skills from an early age. Pupils receive daily lessons and all the graphemes taught are practised in words, sentences, and later on, in fully decodable books. Children review and revise GPCs and words, daily, weekly and across terms and years, in order to move this knowledge into their long-term memory. In addition, the pupils read three times over the week with a focus on decoding, prosody and comprehension. Once the pupils can read fluently, they will become free readers allowing pupils to pick books from a variety of genres and reading levels that are available in their classroom or library. Our expectations of progression are aspirational yet achievable so they can move from learning to read, to reading to learn.
